**PHOTOGRAPHER AND NATURALIST TO DISCUSS NEW BOOK ON ALABAMA RIVERS**

Photographer Beth Maynor Young and naturalist John C. Hall will discuss their new book, *Headwaters: A Journey on Alabama Rivers*, at 3:00 pm on Tuesday Sept. 29, 2009, in the Special Collections and Archives Department of the Ralph Brown Draughon Library.

*Headwaters* is a breathtaking portrait of Alabama rivers. From their primal seepages in the Appalachian highlands or along the broad Chunnenugee Hills, Alabama's rivers carve through the rocky uplands and down the Fall Line rapids, then ease across the coastal plain to their eventual confluence with the Gulf of Mexico.
