1. Submit Online Application to Auburn's Graduate School (https://banssb.prod.auburn.edu/pls/PROD/bwskalog.P_DisLoginNon) and pay the application fee by credit card during the online application session or by check immediately thereafter. Send payment to the Graduate School at the address given in step number 2 below. Do NOT send payment to the Psychology Department; Do NOT enclose payment with this Psychology Department application form.
2. Have your official GRE score report (and TOEFL if applicable) and one official transcript of all undergraduate and graduate credits from each school previously attended (except for credits earned at Auburn University) sent directly to the Graduate School from the issuing institutions so that they are **received** by the Graduate School **no later than December 1** (for admission to the Clinical program) **or January 15** (for admission to the Experimental and Industrial/Organizational programs). The ETS Institution Code number to use to have your GRE scores reported to Auburn's Graduate School is 1005; the address to which transcripts should be sent is: Graduate School, Hargis Hall, Auburn University, AL 36849.
3.
